### 1 APIARY

A place where beehives are kept.

### 2 SWARMING

When bees leave the hive, often in a group, to establish a new colony.

### 3 QUEENEXCLUDER

A device used to prevent the queen bee from entering certain areas of the hive.

### 4 SMOKER

Tool used by beekeepers to encourage bees off of the frames

### 5 POLLEN

Powder-like substance collected by bees from flowers.

### 6 HONEYCOMB

The structure made by bees to store nectar, pollen, and house developing larvae.

### 7 APIARIST

Another name for a beekeeper.

### 8 PROPOLIS

Resinous substance collected by bees, often used to seal cracks in the hive.

### 9 APICULTURE

The practice of keeping and caring for bees.

### 10 COMB

Bees build this to store honey and pollen.

### 11 SUPER

The box placed above the brood chamber to collect honey in a beehive.

### 12 OILSEEDRAPE

A yellow-flowered plant whose seeds are used to produce oil and are a key forage for bees.
